Summer 2010 road and footpath closures due to construction on Brock campus

1 May 10 - May 31: Sewer construction in Jubilee Court

- Work to replace a failed sewer in Jubilee Court.
- This means exterior walkway along the north side of Taro Building, west of Chown A Block will be closed to pedestrian traffic.
- The area will also experience considerable construction noise during this period.

2 May 10 - June 30: Water main construction at Glenridge traffic circle

- Installation of new water main. Construction route will run west from Glenridge Avenue south of the Glenridge traffic circle, along Greenhouse Lane and north beside Alumni Greenhouse.
- The traffic circle will not be closed, though there will be frequent delays.
 Vehicles will still be able to access Parking Lot M, Inniskillin Hall and Residence
 Road along the north (escarpment) side of the campus. Parking Lot A exit will be maintained, with the exception of a few days.

 Besides supplying water for NHBRC, the new main will improve campus water supply for firefighting.

May 10 – Sept 1: Vehicle traffic closed near NHBRC work site

- University Road closed along the south and east sides of NHBRC site. The
 fenced-off construction area will be expanded to make way for installation of
 NHBRC services, parking lot improvements and reconstruction of
 University Road between Glenridge traffic circle and Meter Road (at Plaza Building).
- NOTE: Once this work begins, all vehicles must access main campus via the
 intersection at Glenridge Avenue and St Davids Road. Vehicles entering the
 campus at the small traffic circle (near Lot M and the greenhouse) will not be
 able to access the west side of campus. However they will still be able to access
 Inniskillin Hall, Lot M, and Residence Road along the north (escarpment) side of
 the campus.
- Completion target is Sept 1, at which time the new University Road will be reopened and vehicle access restored.

4 May 10 - Sept 1: University Road and parking lots closed near NHBRC work site

- A-Reserved parking will be temporarily relocated into adjacent Lot A. Visitor parking Lot E will be closed until Sept 1.
- Completion target is Sept 1, at which time access to Lots E and A-Reserved will be restored.

May – Sept 1: Intersection of Meter Road and University Road East

 Recurring temporary closures of this intersection will be needed to allow for excavation work for new buried utilities.
