***Definition of Spouse***  
***Under the Ontario Pension Benefits Act***

Your spouse is the person who, at the date a determination of spousal status is required:

- (a) is married to you and is not living separate and apart from you; or
- (b) is not married to you and has been living with you:
  - (i) in a conjugal relationship continuously for a period of not less than three years; or
  - (ii) in a conjugal relationship of some permanence if you both are the natural or adoptive parents of a child.

**In accordance with the Brock University Pension Plan and the  
Ontario Pension & Benefits Act,  
pension death benefits are paid as follows:**

**Benefits earned prior to January 1, 1987:** the named beneficiary(ies) at the time of death will receive the pension benefit according to the percentages allotted (regardless of whether there is a spouse at the time of death).

**Benefits earned after December 31, 1986:** the spouse at the time of death automatically receives the total pension benefit (100%), regardless of whether the member has designated other people as beneficiaries. A spouse can sign a Pre Retirement Death Benefit waiver, which would allow the member to designate other people as beneficiaries. This waiver can be revoked by the spouse anytime prior to the death of the member.
