The SGSC Awards Sub-Committee has completed its adjudication of the 17 applications submitted to the 11/12 Queen Elizabeth II - Ontario Graduate Scholarships in Science and Technology competition (previously Ontario Graduate Scholarship in Science and Technology). The following six students have been selected to receive the \$15,000/year scholarships for 11/12 (Fall, Winter, Spring).
