Fee Schedule 2007-08

As approved by the Board of Trustees on March 1, 2007, Brock University will be implementing changes in the tuition fee structure for 2007-08.

As permitted and defined by the Ontario government's 2006 tuition fee policy, Brock will be assessing differentiated fees between: (a) first and continuing program year of study and (b) "arts & science and other undergraduate programs" and "professional undergraduate and graduate programs".

The fee information is provided for illustrative purposes for typical situations. The actual fees assessed may vary from these schedules.

MA, MSc, MBE and PhD Graduate Programs

For these programs, tuition fees are charged on a **per term basis**.

First Draft Fee
MA, MSc, MBE and PhD Graduate Programs:
The fee for full-time and part-time students (Domestic and Visa) who have completed all course work and have submitted the first draft of their major essay or thesis will pay **\$284.35 per term**. The thesis or major paper must be completed within the academic term for which the first draft fee is assessed.

Continuous Registration Fee
Master of Education Courses - EDUC 5F95,5P90,5P93 (project or thesis course):
A fee of **\$284.35 per term** will be charged to all full-time and part-time students (Domestic or Visa) for each term registered in the above noted courses following the initial registration in these courses.
