Switching Priority	Infrastructure	Reason	Remarks
1	Lowenberger, Village, Harrison Hall & Kenmore	Large number of students, provides food services. ERT MEETING LOCATION (Kenmore Center)	**Move down in priority if unoccupied. **Note: Lowenberger will have "Life Safety Power"
2	Decew & Vallee Residence	Large number of students, provides food services.	**Move down in priority if unoccupied in the summer.
3	Alan Earp Residence	Large number of students.	**Move down in priority if unoccupied in the summer.
4	Walker Complex	Used to house people in an emergency.	**Move down in priority if not used as emergency assembly area.
5	MacKenzie Chown 'A' Block	Contains Sankey Chamber	
6	Schmon Tower Market Place	Marketplace can provide food services and large seating space	
7	MacKenzie Chown D, G, J Blocks		**Move up in priority if "special requirements" in a lab area.
8	Taro Hall, Plaza 2000, Student Center	Plaza has self contained heating and A/C.	**Move up in priority if extra heating or cooling is needed in loop.
9	Thistle Complex		**Move up in priority if "Theatre" is occupied.
10	Welch Hall, Scotia bank & South Block
