WT (Work Term)	A co-op position with a business that provides the student with a learning opportunity and the business a training ground to witness production from an employee that can be considered for full time employment once the student graduates from his/her degree program. The minimum length of a work term is <b>420 hours</b> and a maximum length is <b>4 months</b> . Work terms can be back-to-back to allow for longer and uninterrupted experiences.
1 <sup>st</sup> , 2 <sup>nd</sup> , 3 <sup>rd</sup> , 4 <sup>th</sup>	Refers to a student's work term that he/she is being hired. A student hired for his/her 1 <sup>st</sup> work term typically will be paid less than a student that is hired for his/her 4 <sup>th</sup> work term.
Toronto	Includes: Metro Toronto and surrounding areas as well as Mississauga and Halton/Peel
Hamilton	Hamilton includes: Ancaster, Brantford, Burlington, Delhi, Hamilton, Simcoe, Stoney Creek, and Waterdown
Niagara	Includes: Beamsville, Fort Erie, Grimsby, Niagara Falls, Port Colborne, St. Catharines, Thorold, and Welland
Other Ontario	Includes: Brockville, Cobourg, Essex, Kenora, London, Kitchener, Oshawa, Orillia, Owen Sound, Peterborough, Lindsay, Pickering, Sault Ste. Marie, Sudbury, Stratford, St. Thomas, Uxbridge, Windsor, etc.
