

Faculty of Graduate Studies Internal Awards, Scholarships and Bursaries

Graduate students are encouraged to apply for any of the awards, scholarships and bursaries for which they are eligible. To be eligible to apply for internal and external awards, scholarships and bursaries, graduate students must be registered as a full-time student. A student who is withdrawn from the university or has a change of status will have their scholarship eligibility reviewed and adjustments to their financial support.

Please note: Deadline dates have been established for the Internal Scholarships/Awards. If the deadline date falls on a Saturday or Sunday, the deadline date is 4:30 p.m. the next working day.

A maximum of three graduate fellowships are awarded each year to new and continuing full-time students in the Master of Education program who have achieved high academic standing. Continuing students will be considered after successful completion of their first year of study. In order to qualify, students must be registered as full-time students.
