What to Bring/What Not to Bring

PROVIDED BY THE UNIVERSITY:

- ✓ Bed, mattress, & zippered mattress protector (twin/single size)
- ✓ Desk
- ✓ Chair
- ✓ Small bedroom garbage can
- ✓ Small bedroom recycling bin
- ✓ Book shelves
- ✓ Dresser
- ✓ Closet space or wardrobe
- ✓ Window Treatments
- ✓ Telephone handset
- ✓ Double-sided sticky pads for hanging room decorations (provided at move-in and available at the service desks)
- ✓ Oven/Stove



- ✓ Kitchen table & chairs
- ✓ Full-sized fridge with freezer component
- ✓ Large kitchen garbage can
- ✓ Living room couch, chair, & table
- ✓ Shower curtain
- ✓ Plunger
- ✓ Central vacuum
- ✓ Two large blue recycling bins for container products
- ✓ One large grey recycling bin for paper products

*All items listed above except for the double-sided sticky pads are University property and must remain with the University at check-out.

WHAT TO BRING:

*Keeping in mind that space is limited and you should only bring what will fit in your room/unit.

Residence Living:

- Bed linen, comforter, & pillows (twin/single size)
- Plastic or metal furniture of an organizational nature which is listed as acceptable on the [Allowable Furniture page](#)
- Clothes hangers & over the door hooks
- Small, compact sized refrigerator with no separate freezer compartment (max. 5 cubic feet) as listed on the [Allowable Appliances page](#)
- Fan with no heater function
- Laundry bag/basket, detergent, & dryer sheets
- Bedroom cleaning supplies
- Towels, face cloth, & bath robe
- Shower shoes & shower caddy
- Washroom cleaning supplies
- Pots & pans
- Dishes & cutlery
- Dish soap, dish towels, & dish rack
- Microwave
- Small appliances (coffee maker, toaster, kettle, blender, etc) which can only be stored and used in the kitchen
- Small freezer (max. 7 cubic feet) which can only be stored on non-carpeted floor in the vestibule, kitchen, or storage room
- Kitchen cleaning supplies
- Garbage/recycling bags
- Barbeque (must be stored and used at least 10 meters from the building and the propane tank cannot be stored in the building)

Academics:

- Alarm clock
- Desk/reading lamp (preferably not halogen)
- Computer/laptop, Ethernet cable, & backup software
- CSA approved surge protected power bar/extension cord
- University documents (admission letter, student card, etc.)
- School supplies

Personal Items:

- Personal documents such as your health card
- Toiletries (soap, toothpaste, toothbrush, mouth wash, floss, shampoo/conditioner, deodorant, sunscreen, etc.)
- TV and DVD player (TV's cannot be wall mounted)

- Radio/stereo
- Headphones
- Camera
- White board/message board
- Extra clothes (a formal outfit, clothes for a job interview, work-out clothes, etc.)
- First aid supplies (bandages, ice pack, polysporin, etc.)
- Emergency sewing kit
- Light-weight decorations (posters, decals, personal pictures, etc.) which must be hung using the University provided double-sided sticky pads
- Outdoor recreation equipment (inline skates, a soccer ball, a Frisbee, etc.)

WHAT NOT TO BRING (PROHIBITED IN RESIDENCE):

- ✗ Any furniture that isn't listed as allowable on the [Allowable Furniture page](#)
- ✗ Candles, incense, or wax/oil lamps
- ✗ Pets (not even as visitors!)
- ✗ Appliances (coffeemakers, hot plates, blenders, etc.)
- ✗ Space heaters (including fans that have a heating function)
- ✗ Beer or any beer-type beverage (e.g. malt liquor) in any type of glass bottle
- ✗ Kegs, "bubbas", Jell-O shooters, Texas Mickeys, other large containers of alcohol (see the RCGP for details), or alcohol-related paraphernalia (e.g. funnels)
- ✗ Ashtrays (all residences are non-smoking)
- ✗ Room alteration or repair materials (paint, nails, window treatments, putty, etc.)
- ✗ Adhesive material other than the University provided double-sided sticky pads cannot be used on residence walls/property (e.g. scotch tape, sticky tack, duct tape, etc.)
- ✗ Firearms, knives, ammunition, items intended to resemble firearms, simulated weapons, fireworks or other explosive/flammable devices and any other weapon or item that is created/intended/used to cause harm or could be seen as intimidating
- ✗ Anything of an illegal nature (illegal prescription and/or non-prescription drugs for recreational purposes, drug paraphernalia, etc.)
- ✗ Sub woofers are permitted but are not recommended due to noise restrictions
