

Brock University has issued a Request for Proposal (RFP) for professional Canadian artists to create an exterior work of art commemorating Sir Isaac Brock, President and Administrator of the Government of Upper Canada (1811-1812) and Commander of the British Forces (1810-1812).

The project is intended to reinforce the sense of history and tradition at the University reflecting Brock's values of courage, leadership, innovation, and inspiration in a way that is forward looking, building on the region's rich historical, geographical and geological past and present. The work is required to be completed and installed on a designated exterior site on the University's main campus for the 50th anniversary of the University in 2014.

The RFP document is only available through Cultural Asset Management Group (CAMG). Respondents must obtain and review the RFP package and submit all documentation within the specified schedule in the RFP package.
