



Fred Truckenbrodt Travel Grant

The Niagara Peninsula Society of the Archaeological Institute of America is pleased to announce the Fred Truckenbrodt Travel Grant. Fred Truckenbrodt (1919-2010) was a loyal and supportive member of the AIA and our society for 28 years. His interest in archaeology took him to local forts, museums, and cemeteries, ancient cities including Athens and Rome, as well as Prof. David Rupp's archaeological cruises around Greece. He attended many Annual Meetings of the AIA as our society's ambassador. Over the years, he met and hosted numerous lecturers, providing them with enthusiastic tours of the Falls and other monuments around the Niagara Peninsula; his home was a frequent venue for Society potlucks.

In January 2010, the AIA recognized Fred as the first recipient of its national Foot Soldier Award. In honour of Fred's memory, the Niagara Peninsula Society has created our own Foot Soldier Award (established in 2011) and a new Travel Grant for students who share Fred's commitment to the AIA, its lectures and activities, and all things archaeological. One travel grant in the amount of \$1000 will be granted on an annual basis in 2012, 2013, and 2014. These grants, awarded by application only, are intended to support student participation in organized archaeological fieldwork or travel in the Mediterranean.

Applications for the grant, available on the reverse of this page and on the AIA's website (<http://www.brocku.ca/humanities/departments-and-centres/classics/AIA-Niagara>), are due by 4:00 PM on April 19th, 2013. In addition to the application form, students are asked to provide a letter of application in which they explain their involvement with the Niagara Peninsula Society, previous travel in the Mediterranean (if any), as well as the project or tour in which they hope to participate.
