

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

Directly from High School

As far as courses that you should be taking in grade 12, students who apply directly from high school to the CHYS program must have a minimum requirement of six Grade 12 U/M courses or equivalent, with English as a required subject and a minimum overall average of high 70s. A Grade 12 U Mathematics (Data Management) is also strongly recommended.

College Transfer

Students from a completed college program must have a minimum 80% cumulative college average for consideration by Child and Youth Studies, and they may receive five full transfer credits with a three-year diploma, three with a two-year diploma, if they are admitted to Brock. The department evaluates all eligible individual student files in consultation with the Registrar's Office after acceptance to Brock has been completed and transferable credits have been awarded.

You will still be entering the first year of the CHYS program, as all students must take CHYS 1F90 and depending on your transfer credits all students need to take PSYC 1F90, SOCI 1F90, one Humanities or Science context credit, and one full elective credit. The awarding of transfer credit is based primarily upon:

1. the compatibility of the previous college program with the Brock program;
2. course content;
3. grades achieved in courses.

Another University

Students with university transfer credits are evaluated on an individual basis, as long as a minimum 65 percent average has been achieved in courses equivalent to Child and Youth Studies credits. Please note however, because of the unique nature of our program you will still be required to take CHYS 1F90. Please contact the Admissions office to answer your additional questions about dates you can apply to the university as transfer credit is usually assessed after you have applied to the university.
