# Job Title: Intramural Officials

Recreation Services

If you play and understand any of the competitive sports offered through Campus Recreation, why not become an official? You will learn the skill of officiating through clinics and evaluations. You'll gain essential skills including active listening, teamwork, confidence, and assertiveness. All officials will be rated based on previous experience, certification and other criteria. You can increase your rating during the season by working to improve.

#### Qualifications:

- 1. Brock University student
- 2. Must represent the Recreation Services program at all times in a manner that exemplifies the principles of Fair Play.
- 3. Officials must have excellent knowledge of the rules of the sport and the ability to apply the rules in a game situation.
- 4. Ability to work well within a team.
- 5. Officiating certification in the appropriate sport is preferred.

## Duties and responsibilities:

- 1. Be very familiar with Recreation Services policies and procedures.
- 2. Knowledge of the sport including Brock Intramural modifications, and the ability to apply the rules in a game.
- 3. Attend all clinics.
- 4. Be available prior to your shift to assist with game setup.
- 5. Be in constant communication with Coordinator of Officials, including providing at least 24 hours' notice if unavailable for shift.
- 6. Ensure you are physical condition to move with the play, and be in position to make appropriate calls.
- 7. Wear appropriate uniform while on duty
- 8. Ensure equipment is signed out and returned to Equipment Room
- 9. Report all incidents, concerns, problems to Convenor, Coordinator of Officials, Intramural Coordinator immediately.

### Conditions of employment:

- 1. Complete staff training and attend clinics appropriate to sport.
- 2. Work flexible hours evenings and weekends
- 3. Apply rules consistently in all games, including modifications made during season.
- 4. Ability to deal calmly, fairly with participants, staff Jobs are available throughout the year. Check the intramural website for officials' training dates.
- 5. All successful applicants who are Brock students and Ontario residents will be required to fill out a student profile for the purpose of obtaining OWSP funding. Employment is not conditional on eligibility status.
- 6. Brock University is required to meet compliance with the Accessibility Standards for Customer Service (Ontario Regulation 429/07). All Brock University Recreation Services student employees must complete the required online training module prior to commencing employment.

**Pay rates:** \$9.50 - 13.25 / hour, as of April 2009

Payment occurs at the end of the sport league and before term breaks.
